ABOUT OUR TRIP

The Ramah Israel Bike Ride & Hiking Trip is the Ramah Camping Movement's premier fundraising effort to support Ramah Tikvah programs at our 15 summer camps across North America and in Israel, providing scholarships, funding new programming, and training staff for the benefit of campers and young adults with disabilities

In May 2022, Ramah Tikvah supporters from around the world will experience Israel's history and beauty as they ride or hike through the breathtaking landscape of Northern Israel, from the Western Galil to the Lebanese border and from Mount Hermon in the Golan Heights to the Sea of Galilee.

All riders and hikers will be active participants in fundraising efforts leading up to the trip.

This will be Ramah's sixth trip. Our five previous trips raised more than \$2.2 million. With your support, we can exceed our fundraising goal of \$500,000 for the 2022 event.

ABOUT THE NATIONAL RAMAH TIKVAH NETWORK

“Tikvah” is the Hebrew word for “hope.” Since the first Ramah Tikvah program opened in 1970, the Ramah Camping Movement has been the pioneer in the inclusion of Jewish campers with disabilities. Each summer, hundreds of children, teens, and young adults with a wide range of intellectual, developmental, and learning disabilities become part of a large, supportive, and inclusive Jewish camp community.

Over the course of the summer, immersive Jewish living with peers—those with disabilities as well as their neurotypical friends—enriches and even transforms their sense of personal identity, strengthens their social and life skills, and helps prepare them to be active and involved members of their communities as they grow into young adulthood. Vocational education programs provide job training experience in a number of service areas both in and outside of camp for young adults ages 18-23.

Thanks to the funds raised by the Ramah Israel Bike Ride & Hiking Trips, new Tikvah programs are developed and existing programs are expanded.
